
Container and Dumpster Services

Mazza Recycling is proud to offer a wide variety of waste containers and dumpsters for rent. Ranging from 10 yards to 40 yards, dumpsters can handle anything, including construction & demolition (C&D) debris, bulk waste cleanouts, concrete, scrap metal, and brush.





Mazza Recycling offers two through ten cubic yard containers for front-load waste and recyclable removal services.



Debris Disposal

Mazza Recycling operates a 46,000 square foot transfer station that can handle up to 1,100 tons of debris per day. It is permitted to accept C&D waste and bulky waste.

Commercial and Residential Recycling

Single stream recycling is a collection method where all recyclables are mixed together in one collection bin. This makes recycling easier for residents while significantly reducing trucking costs and emissions. Recyclables include plastic bottles and containers, cereal and snack boxes, cardboard, office paper, newspaper, magazines, glass bottles, tin cans, and aluminum cans.

Mazza Recycling is committed to maximizing recycling debris, reducing waste to landfills. As part of Mazza's pledge to do our part to ensure global sustainability and the future of our community, we have purchased a state of the art residential single stream processing plant that will have the capacity to efficiently and responsibly recycle all of the tons generated in the communities we serve.







Paper & Plastic Recycling

Mazza Recycling processes all paper grades, including cardboard, office paper, and printer waste. Paper collected is sorted, graded, baled, and taken to a paper mill where it is processed into new products. Mazza also accepts rigid plastic and film. Roll-off, compactor, and baler solutions are available for customers.

Scrap Metal Recycling

Mazza Recycling purchases ferrous and non-ferrous scrap metals at our Tinton Falls and Neptune locations. We pay the highest prices in the area and use state-certified scales for weighing loads. We can also provide containers, trailers, lowboy, or flatbed trailers upon request.






Concrete Recycling

Mazza Recycling's Class B recycling center is permitted to accept concrete, block, natural stone, brick, porcelain, ceramic, and asphalt for recycling. These products are manufactured into DGA, RCA, and subbase for roadways and other building and infrastructure projects. We also have 3/4" clean blue stone, mason sand, and other retail products for landscaping and construction sites.



Mazza Recycling's affiliate, Mazza Mulch, is a NJDEP permitted Class B recycling operation located at our Tinton Falls facility. We accept brush, chips, logs, stumps, clean wood, leaves, and pallets. Mazza also offers mobile grinding service, land clearing, and site management.




Mulch & Landscaping Products

Mazza Mulch processes brush, chips, logs, stumps, clean wood, and leaves to produce organic hardwood mulch, IPEMA Certified Playground Safety Surface, dyed mulches, and topsoil. We offer the following products both wholesale or in bags: Black Velvet mulch, Cherry Brown mulch, Bright Red mulch, Natural Hardwood mulch, topsoil and compost. We offer bagged specialty items such as top soil, mushroom compost, leaf and wood compost, garden soil, and potting mix.





Mazza Mulch houses a 17,500 square foot bagging facility, also known as Second Nature, that has the capacity to produce 5.2 million mulch and soil bags annually. Our team of qualified individuals can help fulfill all bagged product orders to meet deadlines and compliance guidelines for any business.
